



SCHEDULE OF FEES 2018-2019

Education is a major investment in your student’s future. Ojai Valley School is eager to assist families to meet this commitment. In return, we seek families who will make this experience a priority, both in their budgeting of financial resources, as well as their time.

Registration Fee: \$500

This Registration Fee will be refunded upon written request when the student graduates or terminates enrollment at Ojai Valley School, provided all outstanding bills have been paid in full. Fees not refunded will be deposited to the school’s endowment fund.

Tuition Fees: The real cost of an Ojai Valley School education exceeds the amount of tuition fees billed to parents. Tuition fees generally supply 76% of the funds needed to operate the school. The rest is primarily made up by charitable gifts.

Book and Activity Fees: These fees cover transportation for field trips, technology, yearbook, pictures, outdoor education, and weekend activities. In addition, these fees cover weekly allowances given to 7-day boarding students in grades 3 through 12. For Lower Campus students, the fees also provide one set of required textbooks and workbooks. Upper Campus textbooks and workbooks are not included.

Day Bus Service: This service provides a bus run to the Ventura/Oxnard area. Fees for this service are as follows:

Per Student	3,500
Each additional student in family	1,750

Upon acceptance to Ojai Valley School, the student's parent or guardian must pay the \$500 registration fee as well as a non-refundable tuition deposit to reserve a place. The tuition deposit is **\$2,500** for a day student and **\$5,900** for a resident student. The deposit will be credited towards tuition. The registration fee is refundable upon request when the student either leaves the school or graduates.

Tuition payments can be made by check, or wire-transfer. Please contact the Admission Office at admission@ovs.org for wire-transfer information.

Payment Plan I: Payment in full by July 1, 2018.

Payment Plan II: Seventy percent (70%) of the contracted fees, less the tuition deposit and registration fee, are due by July 1 with the remaining thirty percent (30%) due November 1 as noted on the contract.

Payment Plan III: This plan allows the tuition and fees, less the tuition deposit and registration fee, to be paid in four payments. Thirty-five percent of the contracted fees are due May 1 (35%) and July 1 (35%), with fifteen percent due September 1 (15%) and November 1 (15%) as noted on the contract.

Financial Aid: Ojai Valley School maintains a limited financial aid program primarily for re-enrolling students. Please see the Financial Aid form for eligibility and application requirements. In addition to aid, OVS maintains a limited number of scholarships and partners with Your Tuition Solution to provide affordable educational loans.

Other Fees: Miscellaneous expenses incurred by the student will be recorded on the student's account. Clothing, Sport Spirit Packs and any services provided by an outside source will be billed at cost plus 10% handling fee.
