



OJAI VALLEY SCHOOL SCHEDULE OF FEES 2026-2027

Ojai Valley School offers an exceptional educational experience. In structuring our fees, we strive to provide families with many services within the tuition and fees, including after-school care for children, hot lunches for day and boarding students, outdoor education trips, and more, as noted below. The real cost of an Ojai Valley School education exceeds the amount of tuition billed to parents. Last year revenue from Tuition and Fees supplied 82% of the funds needed to operate the school. The rest is made up by generous charitable gifts to the OVS Annual Fund from alumni, parents, friends and other supplemental income. We understand that education is a major investment, and we hope you will make this experience a priority in your budgeting and annual giving.

REGISTRATION FEE: This is a one-time non-refundable registration fee for new students only. \$500

TUITION: Tuition for boarding students covers all meals, housing, and supervision. Tuition for day students includes a hot lunch and after-school care until 5:00 p.m. for Primary and Elementary Division students.

TUITION PROTECTION: Tuition insurance is optional, but not required, for families that pay in one payment (**PAYMENT PLAN I**). Tuition insurance is required for all multi-payment contracts (**PAYMENT PLAN II or III**). The charge will be 2% of the Tuition, net any Financial Aid.

ACTIVITY FEE: The Activity Fee covers the cost of the following items: meals, required textbooks and workbooks in grades Pre-K to 8, transportation for field trips and sports events, weekend recreational activities, outdoor education trips, a Chromebook for students in grades 6 to 8; and health care provided by the OVS Health Center. The student’s account will be charged for sundry expenses incurred by the student, including, but not limited to: student store purchases, transportation to medical, dental, or personal appointments, horse-related expenses, elective class materials, private music lessons, and optional weekend trips.

Upon acceptance to Ojai Valley School, the student’s parent or guardian must pay the one-time registration fee of \$500 in addition to the non-refundable tuition deposit to reserve a place. The tuition deposit is **\$3,700** for a day student and **\$7,700** for a resident student. The deposit will be credited towards tuition.

The tuition deposit can be paid by credit card or ACH. The remaining balance may be paid by credit card transaction with convenience fee, ACH, personal check, cash, or bank transfer.

PAYMENT PLAN I: Payment in full by July 1, 2026.

PAYMENT PLAN II: Seventy percent (70%) of the contracted fees, less the tuition deposit and registration fee, are due by July 1 with the remaining thirty percent (30%) due November 1 as noted on the contract.

PAYMENT PLAN III: This plan allows the tuition and fees, less the tuition deposit and registration fee, to be paid in four payments. Thirty-five percent of the contracted fees are due May 1 (35%) and July 1 (35%), with fifteen percent due September 1 (15%) and November 1 (15%) as noted on the contract.

FINANCIAL AID: Ojai Valley School partners with Clarity, an organization that provides an independent assessment of each financial aid application. Families receiving financial aid must reapply for aid each year. The size of each family’s financial aid award is based on the determined need and funds available in the school's financial aid budget.

DAY BUS SERVICE: This service provides transportation to/from Ventura.
